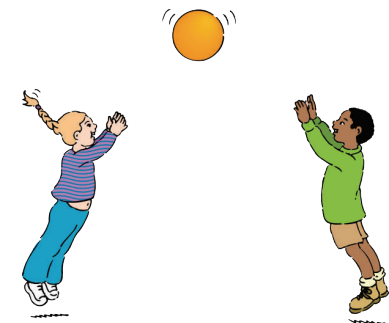

Who Will I See?

- There will be 2 adults who run the group; an Occupational Therapist (OT) and an Occupational Therapy Technical Instructor (OT TI).
- Their job is to make the group as **FUN** as possible and to help you with lots of different skills like throwing and catching, balancing, pencil skills and other fine motor skills.
- The group runs for 5-6 weeks and we will meet for an hour a week with no more than 5 other children.

What Will I Be Asked To Do?

- We will meet in a room with a table and chairs and a bench for sitting on. There may be some soft play equipment which we use as the weeks go on.

What Will Happen After The Group Has Ended?

- At the end of each session your parents/carers will join us so you can share with them what you have been doing.
- During one session your parents/carers may be asked to come and watch, just so they can see what happens during the group.
