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Head Teachers can now choose to purchase added value school health support by selecting from a range of extended services provided by our teams of trusted NHS professionals.

Supplementary services are currently available in Children's Services. These services are specifically targeted at schools' needs and demands which lie beyond the scope of local authority and clinical commissioning group – commissioned 'core' services.

These services enable schools to offer pupils, parents and school staff the clinical support they need to address the broader health-related challenges they face today.

What services can you provide?

We can offer support and training / education to your staff in the following area for children from 0-19 in Speech & Language Therapy, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, School Nursing & Dental Services.

Do these services replace those commissioned by the local authority?

No, the centrally-commissioned ('core') services are still provided. Our Traded Services offer added value support to schools seeking a service over and above the core offer. We will provide bespoke support aligned to schools' individual health challenges, including whole school support as well as input for children and young people who can benefit from services but who do not meet current service thresholds.

Who provides the Traded Services and when will they be provided?

Our Traded Services are provided by our own qualified, registered NHS clinical professionals, usually a named therapist supported by our extensive NHS resources. Services provided are available during term time and within the school day (or other times by agreement). We will work with you to help identify your school's needs and agree a plan with you to address them.

How will Shropshire Community Healthcare NHS Trust provide extra services without affecting core services?

Shropshire Community Healthcare NHS Trust is investing in staff and resources to meet schools' demands for added value services whilst ensuring core services are maintained. In this way our traded services will build upon core services to satisfy the supplementary needs of schools, pupils, their families and school staff.

How much do Traded Services cost?

Charges vary according to the type of service and the amount of time required from our therapy teams. Once we understand your specific requirements we will provide a quotation for you to consider.

Additional costs

Training for groups of more than 15 delegates may incur additional costs. We'll arrange a date for your training session with you – if you need to change the date, a cancellation fee may be charged.

Description of Service/Training	Children entering mainstream schools frequently have difficulties with speech sound development and early literacy skills, most of which will resolve with the right kind of interventions Children who are delayed with their speech development are more likely to have later reading and writing difficulties and have poorer SATS results. Provides training from experienced SLT Assistants. It will support Class Teachers and TA's with practical and transferable skills allowing them to support children in Early Years and KS1 with early phonological awareness skills which underpin speech and literacy development. Course consists of 7 weekly sessions. Session 1 Provides back ground to Sounds Fun and introduces content of practical sessions and importance of observation and scribing. Sessions 2-7 Practical Group sessions, with SLT assistant initially demonstrating and modelling group activities, with class TA gradually taking over responsibility for running sessions. It is aimed at Teachers and Teaching Support Staff but can be particularly effective for a whole school approach or provided for staff from a group of schools. The aim of the training is to provide information on • what stammering is • possible triggers for stammering • identifying the child who stammers • impact of stammering • practical strategies for helping children who stammer in school The training includes resources from the Stammering Information Programme based on research from the Michael Palin Centre for Stammering Children. The original course content was aimed at teachers of secondary and older primary school aged children, but we adapt it to cover any age group being represented. Who the course is for	The course is aimed at Teachers and Teaching Support Staff and is relevant for professionals working with children in preschool and primary ages. The content can be adapted for secondary school staff.	
Description of Service/Training	This is a flexible 2- 3.5 hour course which will be delivered centrally but can also be redesigned and organised for specific settings. The course may be helpful to professionals who are working with children with language impairments, social communication or learning difficulties, or if working in preschool and school settings where children are at risk of developing language skills more slowly. In Western cultures Questions and Answers form the social basis of conversation and discussion, and in educational settings also support teaching and learning. This course allows participants to explore the development of understanding and using questions, their relationship with social communication and links with reasoning. It provides participants with practical advice and ideas for use in one to one and small group support and in adapting whole class teaching. Cost £260 per setting

Children who are delayed with their development are more likely to have later reading and writing difficulties and have poorer SATS and GCSE results. Additional therapy support will help equip staff to have greater understanding of child's needs and how to support them in school setting and help to increase progress and 'add value' to school provision. Support will be provided by experienced SLTs or SLT Assistants who can demonstrate specific strategies and recommend relevant resources to develop individual communication needs of children.
