




First Thousand Words by Usborne books

(Available in many different languages)



This book is a great resource for developing a child/young person's vocabulary. There are several picture scenes all of which cover a different category. Around the edges of each page are pictures of items that can be found in the main picture. This is a great way to discover new words and to revise words as children enjoy looking at the same book over and over again.



How to use the book.

- Take turns to name the items around the edge of the page.
- Take turns to ask each other to find an item in the main picture. Point to the item on the
 edge of the page and say, "can you find the...".
- Talk about the items in the page e.g., "the map is on the wall", "the crayons are on the table".

Other books.

In any book, which has pictures, you can try these activities too:

- Talk about everything you can see in the picture. This includes things that are in the background.
- When you revisit the book take it in turns to play "can you find the...." game.
- Some books have a hidden object to find on every page. Say where this object is hiding.
