What are fundamental movement skills (FMS)?

FMS are the motor skills which underpin participation in physical activity.

What is FUNMOVES?

FUNMOVES is an evidence-based FMS screening and intervention tool which was co-produced with schools to enable teachers to assess the FMS of a whole class within an hour.

- You will receive resources to get your children moving and improve FMS

Why are FMS important?

Research has found that FMS have an impact upon health (both physical and mental) as well as academic performance.







What will this involve for my school?

- 1 hour training with all teaching staff
- Years 1-6 completing FUNMOVES (2 staff members per class)
- Completing complimentary FMS activities in and out of school
- Classes completing the assessment twice, one term apart
